



ICE-PAX® Product Information Thermal GEL General Features

ICE-PAX has been manufactured to meet the changing demands of specialist usage in the Pharmaceutical and Food Industry within the Cool Cold Chain Logistics markets.

While ICE-PAX looks similar to other products it is subtly different in that its tough bag is constructed of a special co-laminar Nylon & Polyethylene extruded film that is more pliable and tolerates frequent sub-zero freeze cycles.

The Gel medium has been specially formulated to provide a firm yet pliable medium at room temperature

**The Gel constituents are NON-HAZARDOUS and classified N.A.D.G
(Classification Not a Dangerous Good) and is completely Food Safe & NON TOXIC**

ICE PAX complies with guidelines for usage in Airline packaging.

Note : If spillage should occur simply wash excess away with generous amounts of water to prevent re-gelling on the spilt area .

Typical Usage – ICE-PAX should be stored flat in the freezer for 24 hours to allow the gel admixture to be frozen & evenly distributed & freeze through the pack.
Simply remove and use after freezing. In practice, the 1 kilo (Large) ICE-PAX will start to freeze after 4 hours at (-) 5 0C
However, if freezer condition is unknown then its best to freeze for 24 hours .

DO NOT PUNCTURE the PACK or MIS-USE the product in any way other than for the purpose to which it was intended.

Standard formats are available with and without bubble (cushion) backing.
